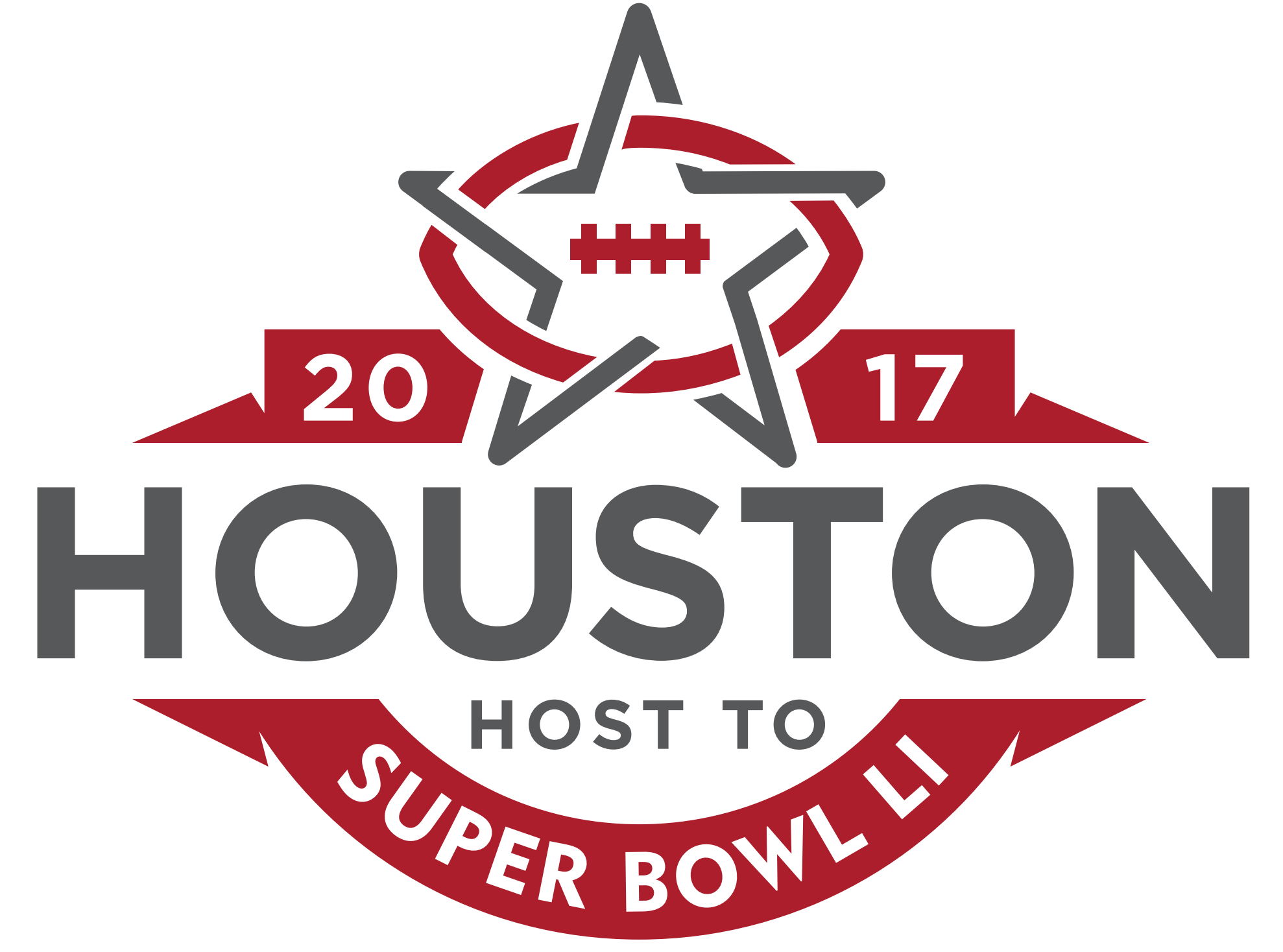


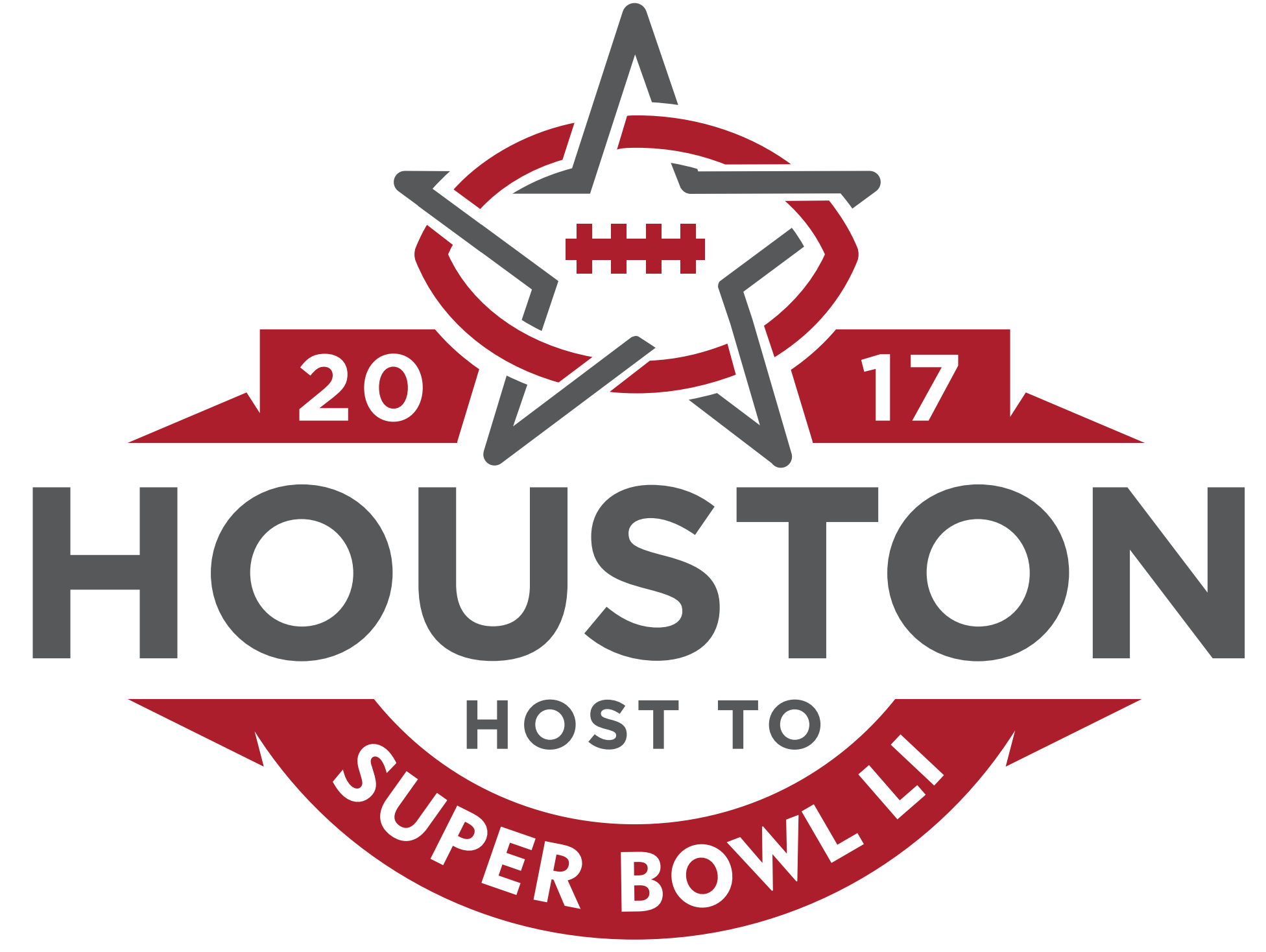

3 CATEGORIES OF ROCK

IGNEOUS

Granite – Formed from hot, molten magma below the Earth’s surface.

Pumice – So light it can float on top of water!

Basalt – Forms the volcanoes in Hawaii & the floors of the world’s oceans.

Obsidian – Used to make knives & other sharp tools.

SEDIMENTARY

Gypsum – The main ingredient in plaster of Paris and dry wall.

Limestone – Mount Everest is made of limestone.

Salt – Used on the food we eat!

Shale – Most oil and gas forms in black shale.

Sandstone – Resistant to weathering. Common building stone.

METAMORPHIC

Marble – State rock of Alabama.

Quartzite – Used as building stone and for countertops.

Gneiss – Are some of the oldest stones on earth.

Slate – Used to make floors, roofs and even pool tables.
